RESOLUTION NO. 14-03

INCREASE IN TAP-IN / TAPPING FEES

December 15, 2014

WHEREAS: The DOWNTOWN Municipal Water Authority has the right, responsibility and authority to charge new customers, additional customers and new service connections a fee and charge referred to as a tap-in or tapping fee (hereinafter "Tapping Fee");

WHEREAS: The Authority had commissioned, paid for and received current updates on said fees, said studies being designated The DOWNTOWN Municipal Water Authority Calculation of the Tapping Fee in accordance with PA. Act 57 of 2003;

WHEREAS: It remains clear that the Authority's Tapping Fees continue to be less than required for new customers becoming part of the system;


WHEREAS: It is necessary and fair to all existing customers that the Tapping Fees be further modified and increased notwithstanding any prior increases;

WHEREAS: Because of all of the system improvements and costs of necessary improvements as well as other capital costs, such increase is necessary.


WHEREAS: Be It So Resolved:

- (1) That the Tapping Fees into the system must be further increased;
- (2) That the existing and current Tapping Fee minimum of Three Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Seven Dollars (\$3,487.00) per EDU shall be, and is hereby, increased to Four Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-One Dollars and Thirty-Seven Cents (\$4,361.37);
- (3) The Tapping Fee per EDU (Equivalent Domestic Unit) was initially calculated per approved engineering standards and guidelines, and may be re-calculated following four (4) consecutive uniform quarters of active use;
- (4) The current Tapping Fee per EDU has been used for more than four (4) consecutive quarters;

- (5) The Rules and Regulations as govern the Downingtown Municipal Water Authority shall be, and hereby are, amended to reflect an increase of the Minimum Tapping Fee pursuant to the above;
- (6) Such increase shall apply to any and all taps which have not been the subject of final approval and prepayment on or before December 31, 2014.
